## **Crochet Zig Zag Pattern**



## **ABBREVIATIONS:**

ch - chain

dc – double crochet

dc2tog – double crochet 2 together

st(s) - stitch(es)

## **MATERIALS:**

Red Heart Yarn - 3 skeins each: navy, white, grey

**Crochet hook size G(6/4.25mm)** 

**Tapestry needle** 

## **NOTES:**

If using 2 or more colors, plan your pattern before starting.

This pattern is 3 rows each color before changing colors.

When changing colors, add the next color on the last stitch of your final dc at the end of the row.

- 1. Decide how many zig zags you want in your afghan. Each zig zag should have 17 stitches.
- 2. Make a foundation chain that is a multiple of 17. If you want 10 zig zags in your pattern, you would chain 174. The last 4 stitches will be your first dc of the pattern.
- 3. Insert your hook into the 4<sup>th</sup> ch from the hook and make a dc.
- 4. DC the next 5 stitches
- 5. DC, ch 2, dc in the next stitch.
- 6. DC the next 7 stitches.
- 7. Repeat steps 5 and 6 to the end of your foundation ch.
- 8. Turn, ch 3 and skip the first st.
- 9. DC the next 2 sts together.
- 10. DC in the next 5 sts.
- 11. DC, ch 2, dc in the next st.
- 12. DC in the next 7 sts
- 13. Skip 2 dc, dc in the next 7 sts.
- 14. DC, ch 2, dc in the next st.
- 15. Repeat steps 9 through 14 to last 8 sts.
- 16. DC in the next 5 sts.
- 17. dc2tog next 2 sts
- 18. DC last st.
- 19. Turn, repeat pattern from step 8 through 18 until desired length is reached.
- 20. When desired length is reached, do not fasten off.
- 21. To add a finished edge, dc in each st around edge of afghan with 3 dc in each corner. Fasten off and weave in ends.
