

Granny Square Afghan for a Baby Doll Bed

MATERIALS:

- A size 7 US (4.5 mm) Crochet Hook
- Worsted/Medium weight yarn in three colors. I used 1 skein each of Yarn Bee Soft Secret (170 g or 6 Oz per skein) in White, Purple, and Lime Green
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

Measurements: 18" Wide X 24" Long

This pattern uses 48 Granny Square. Depending on the size doll bed you are making it for.

PATTERN:

With Color A, ch 4 and join with a sl st to form a ring.

Rnd 1: With same color, ch 3 (counts as first dc), work *ch 2, 3 dc into ring*, rep from * to * twice. End by working ch 2, 2 dc and 1 sl st with color B into 3rd ch st at beg of rnd.

Rnd 2: Using color B, ch 3 (counts as 1st dc) in 1st ch 2 space, work 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in same space, * ch 2, 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc* in next ch 2 space. Rep 3 times. End by join color C with a sl st in 3rd ch at beg of rnd.

Rnd 3: Using color C, ch 1, sc in each of next 2 ch, *ch 2, skip 2 chs, sc in each of next 8 ch, ch 2* Rep from * to * 2 times. Ch 2, sc in next 5 chs. Connect to 1st ch with sl st. Fasten off.

Once you have the granny squares made, sew together with color C.

OPTION:

You can add rows to the last round to bring the afghan over the edge of the doll bed.
